

MALAYSIA



Malaysia is a constitutional monarchy, nominally headed by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong (“paramount ruler”), and customarily referred to as the king who also represents the leadership of Islamic faith in Malaysia. Malaysia has a mixed legal system combining English Common Law, Islamic Law, and Customary Law. Judicial review of legislative acts in the Supreme Court is at the request of the supreme head of the federation.
