**Upon hearing** the Solicitor for the [Petitioner/Respondent]

**It is further ordered** that the said report be signed and delivered by the said Inspector(s) to the District Judge of this Court.

**And it is ordered** that the said Petitioner and Respondent be at liberty to attend at such time and address as may be appointed by the Inspector(s) in order that they may then and there be identified to the Inspector(s) as the parties in this case and examined as stated above.
